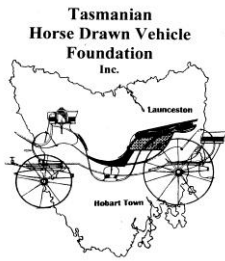

- The event will be judged under Assoc. Internationale D'Attelage De Tradition guidelines and ACDS/FEI rules for cones
- Drivers must be financial members of an affiliated ACDS club and must provide details before competing
- The organisers have the right to:-
  - Alter any advertised times
  - Refuse any entry with or without stating a reason
- An able and responsible adult must accompany all Junior Drivers
- Junior Drivers are to wear an approved riding helmet at all times while driving
