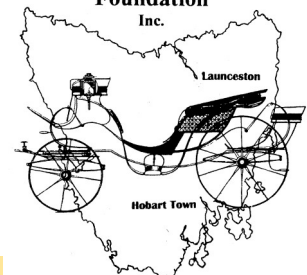
1. Presentation - horse/pony, driver, harness and vehicle
